There were 133 registered delegates that participated in the ICoASL 2013.





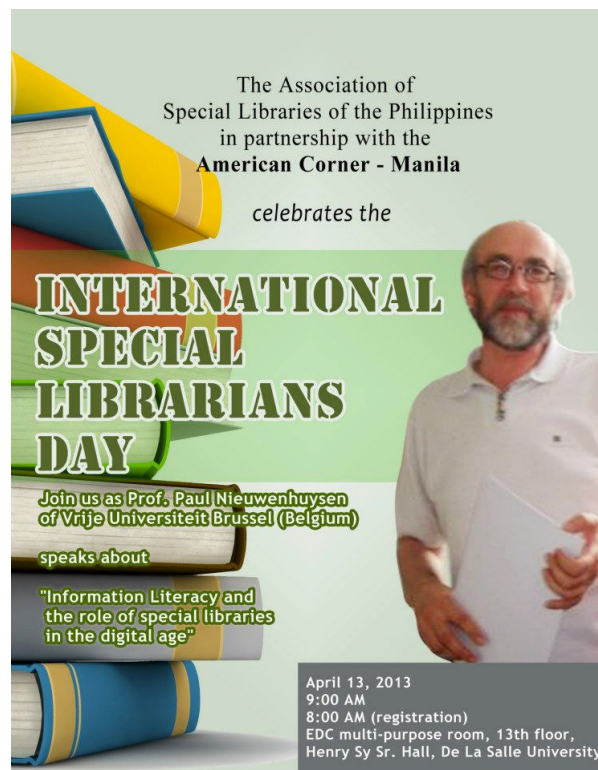
**Event:** International Special Librarians Day: Forum on "Information Literacy and the Role of Special Libraries in the Digital Age"

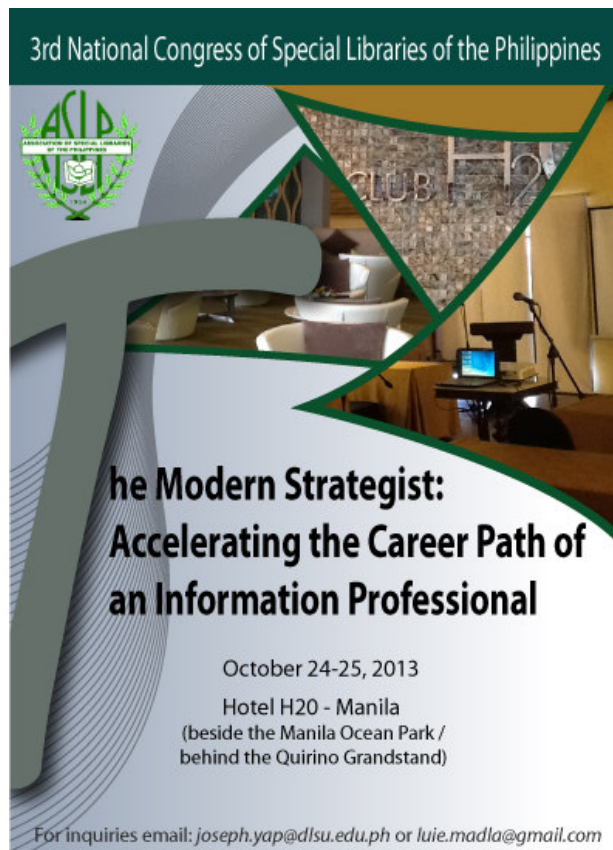
**Theme:** The Modern Strategist: Accelerating the Career Path of an Information Professional
