
Cataloging/Database System: Map Collection





Why migrate to Koha ILS?

Portability / Accessibility

- ability to run in different hardware/software platforms (can work in any device with browser)
- can be accessed anywhere with Internet connection (vs. local network/client-server)

Integration / Standardization

- More efficient search via single portal (vs. multiple, unstandardized databases)
- MARC21 compliant
- Easier linkage

Flexibility

Open source updates/upgrades (vs. custom code)

Maintenance / Support

- Mature/robust system less need for testing (vs. prolonged development time and testing/debugging)
- Cloud server, backup (vs. costly database/web server maintenance)
- Presence of Koha community

Cost

 Free open source system (excluding upgrades, customization, manhours costs) vs. costly programming fees for custom code

Usability / Performance

- Feature-rich
- Improved user interface
