Seminar Registration Fees included kit, accommodation, meals and certificates of participation/appearance.
























The group learned a lot of historical facts from Talisay City's heritage site. This enables the librarians to appreciate more the scenery and the place of the ruins.



2015 SLA ASIA Conference by Ms.Edeliza C. Gallo

The 4th International Conference of Asian Special Libraries (ICoASL 2015) with a theme "Creating the new values beyond library" was held last April 22 – 24, 2015 at the National Assembly Library, Seoul, South Korea.

The event was organized by the Special Libraries Associations (SLA) - Asian Chapter chaired by Ms. Shirley Ingles-Cruz (Philippines), and co-chaired by Mr. Praveen K. Jain and Ms. Medha V. Joshi (India). This was in association with Korea Special Library Association (KSLA) headed by Ms. Kay Sook Park; Korea Institute Science and Technology Information (KISTI) and National Assembly Library (NAL). Providing a platform for exchange of knowledge and skills relevant to the information professional in Asia with a global perspective is the main objective of ICoASL 2015. The event started with a ribbon cutting which opens the exhibit. It was well represented by SLA Officers, KSLA, NAL and KISTI. Present in the ribbon cutting were Ms. Jill Strand, the SLA President: Dr. PK Jain & Ms. Cruz of SLA-Asian Chapter; Ms. Park of KSLA; Dr. Lee of NAL; Ms. Eunju Choi, Chair of the Presidential Committee on Library and Information Policy of Korea and other ICoASL 2015 Committee Members.











Ms. Jill Strand, the 2015 SLA President was the Keynote Speaker of the conference with her presentation entitled Leaning into the Curve: Demonstrating the Value of the Information Professional.

Resource speakers from different countries also shared their knowledge and expertise during the Plenary Sessions like Ms. Diana Chan, University Librarian of Hongkong University of Science and Technology; Dr. Klaus Tochtermann, Professor, German National Library of Economics; Ms.Pascalia Boutsiouci. Head of Consortium of Swiss Academic Libraries in Switzerland; Mr. Kiduk Yang, Professor of Kyungpook National University of Korea; Mr. Richard Savory, Licensing Manager of Joint Information Systems Committee (JISC) of the United Kingdom Various paper presenters coming from countries like USA, Singapore, Indonesia, Korea, India, Pakistan, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, Japan, Iran and the Philippines joined the event.

The ICoASL 2015 was well attended by the professions in the field of library and information science professionals, knowledge managers, information technology professionals, information providers, policy makers, educationist, academicians and other related fields.

The conference was concluded with a tour of library. The tour was divided into two groups: Group A was on the National Library of Korea and Samsung Delight Shop while the other group was at the Underwood Memorial Library at Yonsei aUniversity, Incheon Korea.

Featured Library : Presidential Museum and Library





The Presidential Museum and Library houses the finest and largest collection of references and memorabilia on the history and heritage of the Philippine presidency.

Discover a trove of national treasure that includes an exclusive collection of keepsakes owned by the presidents, past and present.

The Presidential Museum and Library is the primary office within the Office of the President responsible for preserving, managing, and promoting the history and heritage of the Philippine Presidency, and particularly of Malacañan Palace as its official seat. It is the principal historical and artistic repository in support of the institution of the Presidency and for the benefit of the Republic and the Filipino people


It exercises primary curatorial, conservation, preservation, custodial, and advisory responsibilities over structures, and facilitates the conduct of tours of designated areas within the Palace.

It was created in 2004 with the implementation of Executive Order No. 366, issued by President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, which merged the Presidential Museum and the Malacañang Library into one office as the Malacañang Museum. The collections of both offices were integrated and housed in Kalayaan Hall, while others were placed in off-site storage facilities.

In 2010, Executive Order No. 880 was issued, placing the Malacañang Museum under the supervision of the National Museum for museological and related policy purposes. Later on, Executive Order No. 4, promulgated by President Benigno S. Aquino III, placed the Malacañang Museum under the supervision and control of the Presidential Communications Development and Strategic Planning Office. The issuance likewise renamed the Malacañang Museum as the Presidential Museum and Library.

DR. ESTRELLA V. MANUEL LIBRARIAN OF THE YEAR

The Association of Special Libraries of the Philippines (ASLP) would like to congratulate Dr. Estrella Velasco Manuel for being the "Outstanding Professional of the Year" in the field of Library Science. The award was given by the Professional Regulation Commission during the Awards Night, a highlight of the PRC Anniversary Celebration and Professional Regulation Week at the Fiesta Pavillion, Manila Hotel last June 18, 2015.

This is the highest award conferred by the PRC since 1997 to professionals who gives an exemplary service and dedication to the profession.

Dr. Manuel was the pioneer of Library Science Program of the Polytechnic University of the Philippines since 1978. Her dedication to the university cannot fathom. She was then the director of the PUP Library and head of the Library Science Department.

Dr. Manuel demonstrated the highest degree of professional competence by serving the profession for almost sixty three years. Now, she continues to love the profession by being one of the professors in Library and Information Science program in PUP.

She has an active participation with different professional organization both local and international such as the International Federation of Library Associations (IFLA) and the Orientalist Organization of Asian Librarians. She even became an officer of the following association: Board Member of the Philippine Librarians Association (PLAI), Vice President (1988 – 1989) Philippine Association of Teachers of Library Science (PATLS), and President of the Philippine Society on Curriculum Development.

Dr. Manuel also authored the book on Philippine School Librarianship and other research publications.

A woman full of achievements who shared her life and strength not only to the university she served but in every student's that she taught and every life that she touched, truly she deserved to be THE OUTSTANDING PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR.
