It was held at the Hearing Room of the Supreme Court of the Philippines with a theme —ASLP@60: Globally Moving Forward - a theme that supports the ASLP's vision. Honorable Chief Justice Ma. Lourdes P. A. Sereno served as the Inducting Officer. Total of 72 participants attended this event.

In this very first venture of the 2014 ASLP Board, I already felt the eagerness of each and everyone to help and work towards that attainment of the association's goals. Everybody have shared and voiced out their thoughts and fruitful ideas regarding to the different activities the association that undertook for 2014.

It was indeed a very fun and productive planning for we were able to plot all the activities for the year.

Our first major activity was the Training-Workshop on the Basics of Preservation, Conservation, Restoration & Data Curation in partnership with Special Libraries Association – Asian Chapter that was held at Legazpi City on April 10-12, 2014.

The main objective of the conference is to bridge the gap of learning by linking special libraries and institutions through collaboration and sharing of valuable ideas and expertise in the fields of preservation, conservation, restoration and data curation.

Because of the abundant innovation in the field of information and having the goal of bringing closely to the people all of these information, ASLP conducted a Forum on Information Resource Sharing held at the Kalayaan Hall, Malacañang Palace on July 11, 2014. Sec. Edwin Lacierda was the resource speaker.



Mr. Randolf Mariano, ASLP PRO and Librarian of the Thomas Jefferson Information Center also had his share of different open source websites which were useful for information professionals. 81 participants that included professionals, paraprofessionals and students of library and information science joined the forum.

Dir. Ryan Faustino of the Presidential Museum and Library who gave the welcome remarks during the event, also provided a free tour for all the participants.

Our Forum on Effective Citizen Journalism during the 35th Manila International Book Fair supposedly on September 19, 2014 was cancelled due to bad weather condition that time. However, we rescheduled the forum and pursue the conduct of the event on October 9, 2014. It was held at the Supreme Court Library with Ms. International 2013 Bea Rose Santiago as the resource person. 14 participants attended this event.

On October 22-24, 2014 at the Hotel Veniz, Baguio City, the 4th national Congress of Special Libraries of the Philippines (NCSLP) was held with the theme "Restructuring

the Library: modern and contemporary techniques in redesigning libraries."

The primary objective of the seminar was to give insights and ideas for librarian and information professionals in designing their libraries to make it more appealing to library users. Dr. Klaus Ulrich Werner of the University of Berlin, Germany shared modern techniques in redesigning libraries in the Western world which can be adopted by our libraries here in the country. Also, Mr. Dhobbie De Guzman and Architect Robert Romero of the University of Cordillera and again our beloved adviser Ms. Milagros Santos Ong shared their personal experience and technical know-how on library designs. 57 participants attended the seminar.

ASLP was one of the library associations who participated in the parallel session during the PLAI National Congress held at Century Park Hotel on November 27, 2014. Our adviser, Ms. Shirley Cruz and our PRO Mr. Randolf Mariano were the resource speakers for the ASLP.

The 2014 ASLP Board also renewed its subscription to wiki courtesy of the generous incoming president Ms. Brin Alejandrino. 4 issues of the ASLP newsletter were released and uploaded in the association's wiki page thru the effort of our PRO, Mr. Randolf Mariano.

ASLP Board and members were also visible and participated in numbers of events.
